

Lesson Basics- Textbook

Encourage students to self-manage text book activities to ensure quality outcomes

Textbooks can be a great way to test students understanding of a concept and to disseminate new information. The hard part to this however is to maintain pace and to ensure that students fully understand what needs to be completed when they first engage with the task. The easy way to approach this is to use timings, ask them to actively engage with the text through identifying key words and finally to always check back to see if they have done what is required.

Spotlight/Focus...

- Read the task carefully and identify the keywords
- Manage your time carefully to ensure you complete the task
- Check the completed work against the task and keywords

Teacher spotlight...

- Try to encourage the use of a pre-task analysis of what is required supported by using SUB
- Use this analysis to check the completed task against
- Apply timings so that students can manage the pace that they work at
